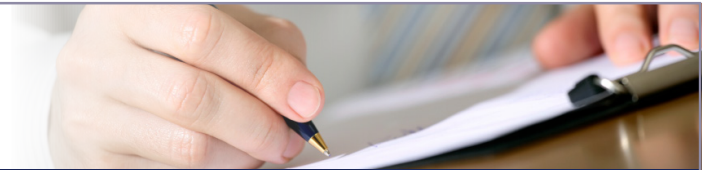

NEW GOVERNMENTAL WEBPAGES ON HEALTHCARE REFORM

The [White House](#) and [Health and Human Services](#) (HHS) web sites provide general information about health reform and question and answer sections, and an [IRS webpage](#) provides information about the new small employer tax credit. - For Employers - This document lists healthcare reform items that are relevant to small employers, larger employers, and all employers.
- Summary - This summary document provides an overview of PPACA and breaks the law into nine categories, summarizing key points of interest under each.
- Implementation Timeline - This document provides a brief description of the many components of health care reform that will become effective over the coming years, from 2010 through 2018.
- Insurance Market Reform - This document provides information about the various health insurance marketplace reforms.
